Blum clip-on hinges are used on all cabinetry and Blum tandem full-extension concealed slides for the drawers. Soft closing mechanisms on all drawers and doors are another option.

Morantz also provides high-quality eco-friendly cabinetry. Many of the man-made materials use glues and finishes that can affect your health, especially in closed, air-conditioned environments such as South Florida. Lyptus and European beech are two of the green products on the market and can be substituted for tropical woods like mahogany. These are grown in managed forests for maximum yield and less stress on the environment. Two other products new to the market are bamboo and coco palm that are being made into panels for cabinetry, are solid throughout and have no harmful glues. As bamboo can grow a foot a day, both are renewable resources.
